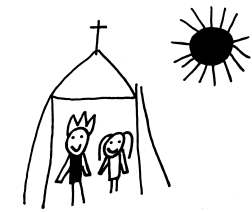

We recognise the individual needs, interests and abilities of each child and experiences are provided to further develop the uniqueness of each child.

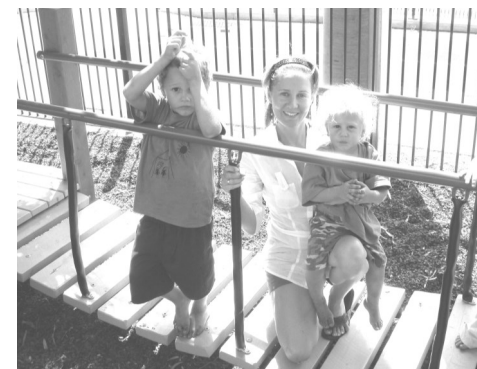


About the Kindergarten

Faith Kindy opened its doors in February 2006. The Kindergarten is a not-for-profit Community Organisation, co-located on the grounds of Faith Lutheran College, Redlands. It offers a five day fortnight program for children in the year prior to Prep. The Kindergarten operates in accordance with the Education and Care Services National Law Act 2010 and the Australian Education and Care Quality Authority to ensure the highest standards of care and education are offered to our families.

The Kindergarten is managed by Queensland Early Childhood Services (QLECS). The QLECS Children's Services Manager (CSM) provides operational oversight to the Kindergarten, as well as support and advice on a range of human resource requirements, curriculum support, strategic planning and quality improvement matters.

Staffing - Faith Lutheran Kindergarten is a double unit Kindy and consists of two registered Early Childhood Teachers (minimum 4 year Teaching Degree) and two Teaching Assistants (minimum Certificate III in Children's Services). The Director, who is also a Kindergarten teacher, collaborates and reports to the QLECS Early Childhood CSM, and liaises closely with members of the Parent Liaison Group.
