



## SENIOR SCHOOL YEAR 12 JERSEY POLICY

### Rationale:

It is an important demonstration of pride, identity and rite of passage in the life of Year 12 students that they undertake the task of designing the Year 12 Jersey. This is a piece of apparel that can be worn by Year 12 students whilst at school and when wearing normal school uniform. The Jersey can be worn with P.E. Uniform and whilst representing the College at Sporting Fixtures. It is not intended to be worn on excursions other than sporting events.

The Jersey is not to be worn when travelling either to, or from school.

### Policy:

1. The Year 12 Jersey is to be worn only by Year 12 students and staff of the College.
2. It is to be worn with pride and identifies students as belonging to and representing Faith Lutheran College, Redlands.
3. Normal expectations of student behaviour are required whilst wearing the Year 12 Jersey either at school or elsewhere.
4. The Year 12 Jersey is to be designed by a representative group from Year 12 in consultation with College staff, with the final design and labelling approved by the College.
5. It is not to be worn either to or from the College or in combination with College blazer under any circumstances.
