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Faith Lutheran College, Redlands Instrumental Music Enrolment and Contract 2016



The instrumental Music Program offers specialised instrumental and vocal tuition for students. To further the benefits of specialised lessons, instrumental and vocal students are expected to be involved in the College ensemble program as **part** of their music education.

COMMITMENT

Students are expected to remain committed to lessons for the entire year.

However, this may be reduced to a minimum of 1 semester (x2 terms), only if parent(s) provide <u>written</u> <u>notice of withdrawal</u>, which must be received by the Head of Extra Curricular Music P-12 <u>at least 4</u> <u>weeks prior to the end of semester 1</u> (i.e. 4 weeks before end of term 2) that they wish to withdraw students from lessons.

If notification is <u>NOT</u> received within the timeframe allowed, it will be deemed parents' confirmation of students continuing enrolment for THE FOLLOWING SEMESTER. Students are expected to commit for a full semester and are not permitted to cease tuition during the semester.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF PARTIES

- a) Responsibilities of the Head of Extra Curricular Music P-12 and the Music Department:
 - To provide a timetable of lesson times for each term, which may be amended from time to time;
 - After tuition has commenced, provide ongoing feedback and details of preparation required for each lesson via a post to an instrument specific Edmodo page, or JS student diaries;
 - Communicate with parents to discuss issues or concerns;
 - Recommend resources to be purchased by the student;

b) Responsibilities of Student:

- Consistently attend lessons at specified times;
- Consistently attend rehearsals AND performances at specified times;
- Students must be involved in the ensemble program as part of their music education, whether as a vocal student in choirs or an instrumental student in ensembles;
- Prepare for lessons in accordance with the instructions of the teacher/tutor
- Maintain a consistent practice schedule at home;
- Adhere to behavioural standards established for students attending Faith Lutheran College, Redlands.

c) Responsibilities of Parents:

- Ensure students attend rehearsals AND performances at specified times;
- Ensure the Music Tutor or Head of Extra Curricular Music P-12 is notified immediately if a student is unable to attend a lesson or performance due to illness;
- Ensure students are properly prepared and equipped for lessons by purchasing resources recommended by the teacher/tutor.

FEES (Invoiced by FLCR):

Faith Lutheran College Redlands has employed highly qualified and motivated full time and part time staff to provide the very best possible musical enrichment program for your children.

Instrumental music fees are consistent with those set by the Music Teachers' Association of Queensland.

- Lessons are of 30 minute duration on a rotational timetable.
- Some more advanced students may wish to have 45 minute of 60 minute lessons. These are available through contact with our Music staff at Faith, or email at music@flcr.qld.edu.au Payment for these will be on a pro-rata basis.

• A minimum of eighteen (18) lessons will be provided per Semester.



- Enrolments for the ongoing <u>annual instrumental music program</u>, are <u>payable in</u> <u>advance of start of lessons each term</u> and are <u>non-refundable</u>.
- Students will be invoiced by Faith Lutheran College, Redlands Business Office.
- Fees are <u>not</u> charged on a per lesson basis.
- Students will have lessons for the duration of each term, with the exception of the first week of Term 1 and the last week of Term 4.
- Students will NOT be allowed to start lessons each term until payment has been received.

ENROLMENT OPTIONS: Parents can enrol and pay by term or annual (x4 terms).

- If the student is unable to attend a lesson due to a school related event, i.e. excursion/incursion, assessment/exam etc, it is the responsibility of the student to make alternative arrangements with the Music Tutor, at least 48 hours prior to the scheduled lesson. If this is not organised, lesson fees will still apply and the lesson will not be made up;
- If students take additional holidays during term time, notice must be given to the Music Tutor and Head of Extra Curricular Music P-12. If this is not organised, lesson fees will still apply and the lesson will not be made up;
- If the student is absent due to illness, notification must be given to the Tutor or Head of Extra Curricular Music P-12 by phone or email (<u>music@flcr.qld.edu.au</u>) no later than 9am of the scheduled lesson day. If notification is not provided within this time, lesson fees will still apply and the lesson will not be made up.

INSTRUMENT LOAN SCHEME:

Faith Lutheran College, Redlands has purchased a limited number of Brass, Woodwind and String instruments to enable students to gain skills and experience on that instrument and participate in College Ensembles.

- Instruments will be loaned for a **non-refundable \$150 per calendar year** as outlined in the Instrument Loan Agreement.
- It is anticipated that at the end of the loan period, parents will purchase or hire an instrument for the student to continue playing, except in the case of larger instruments which are often loaned to one student for several years.
- Students who are given a secondary instrument to play in particular ensembles will be required to pay a non-refundable Occasional Loan fee of \$80 per calendar year to cover maintenance costs, as outlined in the Instrument Loan Agreement.
