	<p>Three Senior School Year 12 students came to present to us how the Shine program is going at the high school.</p> <p>Term 2 they built strong connections with the girls which built a lot of confidence.</p> <p>There are 12 girls, 6 leaders and the program is overseen by Sarah Day.</p> <p>The students thanked the P&FA for their contributions this year which funded their program and R U OK day.</p> <p>The Strength program for the boys has 5 teachers running it with 7-8 boys from Year 10 attending, at the moment these sessions are being funded by the College.</p> <p>The programs have helped the students with greater connections from Middle to Senior School.</p> <p>The students are looking for some year 11 students to take over the program for next year once they finish school.</p> <p>The P&FA then discussed funding the programs for next year, and recognition for the girls who have been running it.</p> <p>The P&FA are presenting \$1000 for the Shine program and \$1000 for the strength program for a total of \$2000.</p> <p>Tania passed the motion and was seconded by Kerry Richards.</p> <p>Catherine will look into an award, possibly the Make a change award.</p>

Catherine is looking for volunteers, about 8 people for the serving and cooking from 4.30pm to start serving at 5.30pm. Tania will be there and Kerry has volunteered also. Tania will do an introduction on the night.</p> <p>Catherine has had a request from ABC rides to see if we will use them again next Funfest? ABC have a great safety record.
