

Principal's Report to P&FA 1-2-16

1. Student Leadership

The Student Leadership program at Faith has developed very well over the years. This morning we installed into office the Student Leaders in the Middle and Senior School and will do this with the Junior School students soon. Students at Faith are involved in a strategic program of leadership training that includes, but is not limited to the following elements:

- 1.1. Leadership as part of the camping and outdoor education program:
- 1.2. Service Learning at a College level, including FLAT Vanuatu and Social Justice Group;
- 1.3. Australian Lutheran World Service Awareness Days;
- 1.4. Lutheran Youth of Queensland leadership training both in the College and specific youth leadership camps;
- 1.5. Regular meetings with staff to set up collaborative structures and involve students on College decision making;
- 1.6. Mentoring and peer support program across all 3 sub-schools; and
- 1.7. Leadership positions for students across a range of areas, skills and competencies.
- TAS Sport was off to a speedy start with fixtures after only 3 days of school, because of the short 9 week term we have. Swimming carnivals are upon us, as well as the year getting off to a flying start.
- 3. Faith Leaving A Trail (FLAT) Service Tour takes place again this year in the June/July holidays. We have 2 groups traveling to Fokona Village to work with the people of that village. Fundraising commenced in 2015 and will continue this year. Once again, this promises to be a great learning experience for our community.
- 4. Our online canteen is beginning to gain traction across the College as online purchases for both the canteens and College Shop now become available. Instructions on setting up accounts has been posted to the College website.



- 5. Specialist Science classes in the Junior School have been introduced in 2016. Parents may have heard of the government education authorities making a push for Science specialists in the Junior School or maybe STEM (Science, Technology Engineering and Maths) programs. We are excited about the opportunities that this will bring for our students.
- 6. A meet and greet with the new Music Tutor team will occur tomorrow evening. Details are over the page.
- 7. Parent IT workshops. Our IT staff have suggested that we run some IT workshops for parents especially in regard to the devices, programs and software that our students are using. It has been suggested that this be done in conjunction with P&FA meetings, possibly 30 minute workshops before each P&FA meeting. We ask the P&FA to consider this.
- 8. Last year we had some student leaders attend a P&FA meeting and speak about their activities. It was very well received and we would like to repeat this. The Senior School students had a submission to the Wishlist last year and have purchased and set up an area in the LOFT for study purposes. We would like to hold the next P&FA meeting in the LOFT hosted by the students, where they can do a 'show and tell' about the study facility and also speak about the progress with the other items they are working on. We will ask the P&FA meeting tonight to consider this request.
- 9. I wish to acknowledge the work of the P& FA from 2015 and in particular thank the executive committee; President Tania Russell, Vice-Presidents Geoff Fowler and Nicky Ross, Treasurer Greg Fowler and Secretary Glenn Gray for their wonderful efforts and commitment to the College. We wish the new elected officers every blessing in their roles and sincerely thank them for their service.
