Bring Your Own Device Independent Purchase Guidelines Minimum Device Specification



Our vision for Technology in the classroom is consistent with our College vision of providing quality learning opportunities while nurturing the development of all students in a Christ-centered community. As we invite digital transformation into our classrooms, learning becomes alive, rich, relevant, engaging and timely. Through iPad use in the classroom students have the opportunity to recreate, publish, remix and innovate. It is essential that the 'citizens of the future' are able to effectively and ethically incorporate this emerging technology into both their personal and professional lives as they develop.

The College continues to place an emphasis on preparing students for contemporary learning. When technology is integrated into the classroom it fosters the skills of collaboration, communication, creativity and divergent thinking. To maximise learning in today's technology context Faith Lutheran College, Redlands (FLCR) require that all students in Years 5 and 6 have access to a personalised digital device (iPad/Tablet).

Students in Year 3 and 4, in 2020 are being given the choice to 'Bring Their Own Device' (iPad/Tablet). This is a choice and not compulsory. If you choose to bring your own device there is a list of minimum specifications in the document below. Families may purchase a device from our School Locker Portal to take advantage of discounted pricing and payment options. Families may also choose to purchase the device at other retail outlets. For students and families where this is not possible, a College device will continue to be offered.

All students in Years 5 - 12 are expected to bring their own device to school each day from Term 1, 2020. It is expected that these devices will meet the College's minimum specifications, in the Junior School the recommended device will be an iPad. As this will be the student's own personal device there is the personal responsibility for purchase and arrangements around warranty, insurance and software requirements.

What is BYOD?

Bring Your Own Device program allows students to bring personal devices to school for use in academic work in the classroom. This enhances student's interface with digital educational resources which in turn enhances learning and student productivity.

At FLC	the BYOD policy stipulates that:
	he device must meet the minimum specified standards.
	For students in Years $3-6$ the recommended devise will be an iPad, however, other indroid tablets may be considered as an option on a case by case basis.

The Co	ege will provide technical support to all students in this way:
	Wi-Fi connection;
	Email setup;
	Office 365 support; and
	Support of installation of other applications that may be used.

Please note: While IT Support will endeavour to support students as much as possible, as the device is a student's own personal equipment, any warranty, insurance and service arrangements are the responsibility of families.

Applications (Apps) required

Students will receive a list, in January before Term 1 commences, detailing what apps will need to be installed on their iPad via the iTunes store. In addition to this, all students will need Family Sharing set up on their iTunes account to ensure students can self manage the device throughout the school day. Support is important so the following will be offered at the start of the school year:

Parent and Child Device set up session prior to the school year commencing. This
will allow us to support installation of required apps, setting up Family sharing
accounts, student email set up and connection to the college wifi.

□ Student 'Boot Camp' sessions will take place in week 1 of the school year to support student set up and use of the device to prepare them for the year ahead.

Optional	Stylus (Apple Pencil or Logitech Crayon) – if iPad model supports apple pencil




Complete the Create an Account form.

If you DO have a Student Advantage number provided by your school (via email or on a Student Advantage Card) enter it in the Student Advantage Card Number field and click SUBMIT.

If you DON'T have a Student Advantage Number, skip the Student Advantage Information section and click SUBMIT.

If you DO have a Student Advantage Number enter it in the Student Advantage Card Number field and press SAVE.

A pop-up window will appear. Complete your details including Parent/Guardian Name, Email Address, Student Name, School and Year Level. Click **SUBMIT**.
