Faith Lutheran College Redlands Instrumental Music Enrolment Contract 2022

The Instrumental Music Program offers specialised instrumental and vocal tuition for students to become musicians through the development of musical literacy, technique and performance. Participation in ensembles and choirs is an essential component of our program.

COMMITMENT

Students are expected to commit to the program for the entire year and ALL students must participate in an ensemble.

PROGRAM COMPONENTS

The Instrumental Music Program incorporates experienced private instructors of Strings, Brass, Woodwind, Percussion, Guitar, Piano and Vocals who can take students through exams or simply provide the necessary skills to enjoy playing.

Lessons

Individual and Group lessons are the avenue through which music literacy, techniques and performance skills, specific to the instrument and level of the student, are explicitly taught. Lesson groupings are like-instrument and/or like-ability levels.

Ensembles

Ensembles provide the opportunity to demonstrate learning on their instrument in real-life contexts.

Home Practice

It is expected that students will complete regular home practice to make musical progress on their instrument.

FEES (Invoiced by FLCR):

Instrumental music fees are consistent with those set by the Music Teachers' Association of Queensland.

Fees are charged on a yearly basis divided equally into 4 terms.

- Students will have lessons for the duration of each term, with the exception of the first week of Term 1 and the last week of Term 4.
- Lessons do not occur on Public Holidays or Pupil Free Days.
- Lessons are of 30-minute duration on a rotational timetable during the school day.
- Some more advanced students may wish to have 45 minute or 60 minute lessons.

- Music Fees include timetabled lessons, ensemble rehearsals, workshops and events.
- Instrumental Music Fees will be billed on the annual fee statement. Fees are
 payable by the due date nominated by the College. The College reserves the right
 to withdraw lessons where Music Fees are in arrears.

INSTRUMENT LOAN SCHEME:

Faith Lutheran College, Redlands has purchased a limited number of **Brass**, **Woodwind** and **String** instruments to enable students to gain skills and experience on that instrument and participate in College Ensembles.

- Instruments will be loaned for a **non-refundable \$180 per calendar year** as outlined in the Instrument Loan Agreement.
- It is anticipated that at the end of 12 months, parents will purchase or hire an instrument for the student to continue playing, except in the case of larger instruments which are often loaned to one student for several years.
- We do not have Guitar, Keyboard or Percussion instruments for loan.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

- If the student is unable to attend a lesson due to a school related event, i.e. excursion/incursion, assessment/exam etc., it is the responsibility of the student to make alternative arrangements with the Music Tutor or Head of Extra Curricular Music P-12, at least 48 hours prior to the scheduled lesson. If this is not organised, lesson fees will still apply and the lesson forfeited.
- If students take additional holidays during term time lessons will be forfeited.
- Students who attend Mount Binga Outdoor Education Program will receive hour lessons for the alternate weeks they are at school where possible.
- If the student is absent due to illness, notification must be given to the Music Tutor or Head of Extra Curricular Music P-12 by phone or email <u>jacinta.altmann@flcr.qld.edu.au</u> no later than 7:00am of the scheduled lesson day. If notification is not provided within this time, the lesson will be forfeited.
- If a Music Tutor is unwell, lessons will be rescheduled where possible.
- A reconciliation will be done at the end of the year and credits will be applied to the fee account for any lessons not provided.
